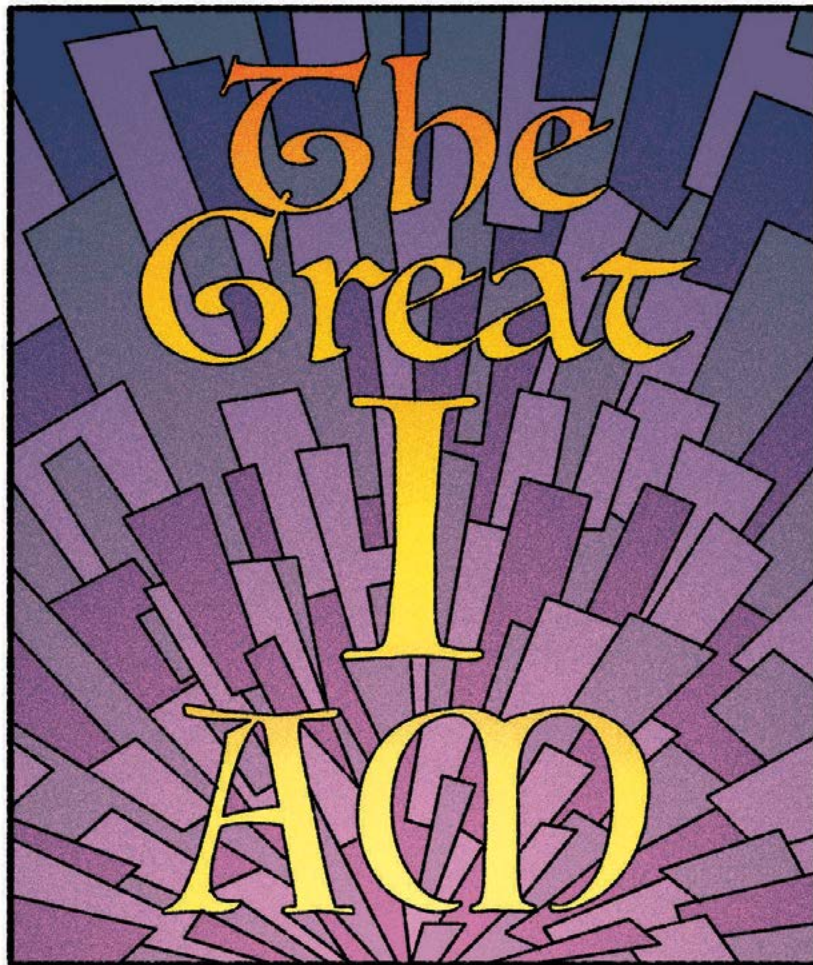

INTRODUCTION

In Exodus chapter three, Moses approached God by way of a burning bush that was not consumed. God warned Moses to not come near because the place on which he stood was holy ground. Then God identified himself as the God of his father, the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

After some back-and-forth between the two, Moses asked God, “Who shall I say sent me?” In other words, “What is your name?” The answer must have reverberated like thunder coming out of the red-hot bush: I AM WHO I AM—The Great I AM.

Isaiah 9:6 lists four names of God: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. And Scripture is filled with other names and titles of the Almighty and Triune God.

Jesus is God incarnate. He took on human flesh and lived among us. Yet He was still fully divine and displayed His majesty in miraculous and glorious ways. This little book is not exhaustive, but it lists many of the names of Jesus. Each page illustrates one of His names with a creative stained-glass image and Scripture reference. This book is meant to be a quick and beautiful reminder of all that Jesus is—in name, title, attributes, and actions.

Share it with your kids. And print out some of the coloring book pages as an activity they can do while meditating on one of the many wonderful and mighty names of Jesus.

Should I smile or shake in fear?

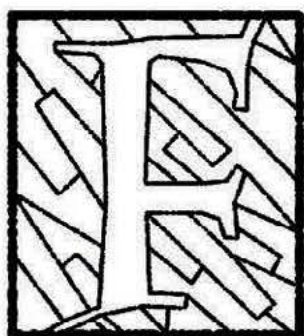
His Word reveals a truth:

One with my God, Amen.

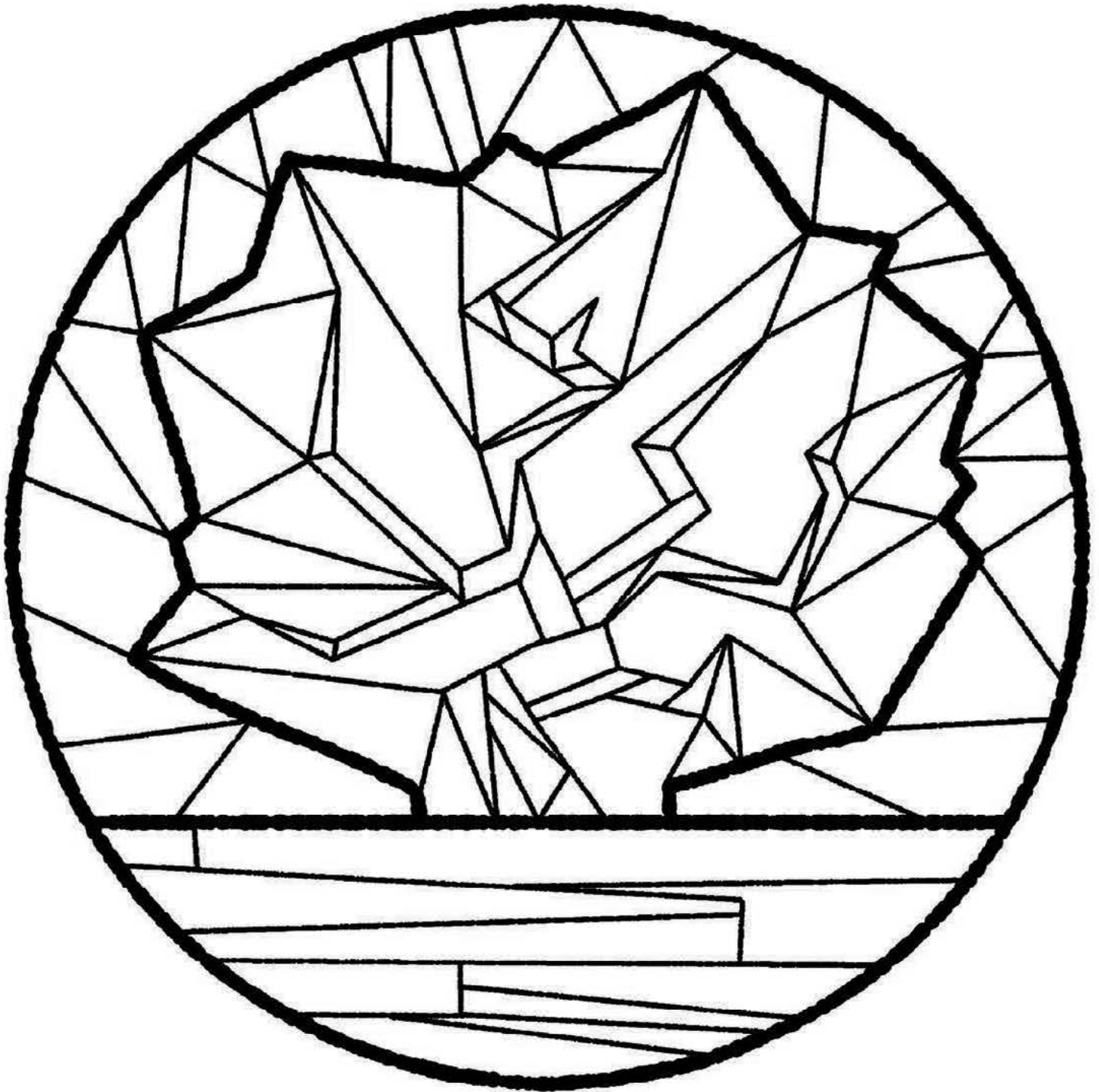
